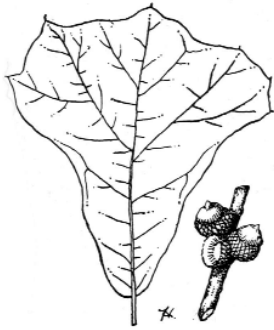


# KNOW YOUR HILL COUNTRY OAKS

(East Texas native)

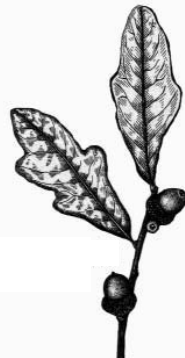
(\* Red oaks infected with oak wilt can form fungal mats.)



**Plateau Live Oak**  
*Quercus fusiformis*

(Live oaks are susceptible to oak wilt but do not form fungal mats.)

*Quercus breviloba*



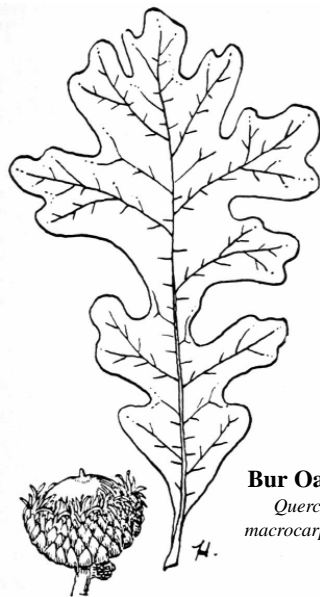
**Lacey Oak/

*Quercus glaucooides*



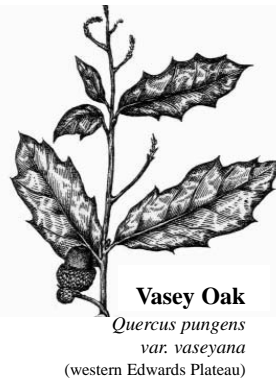
**Chinkapin Oak**  
*Quercus marilandica*



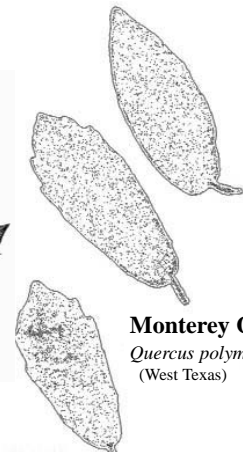
**Post Oak**
