

Wildfire Ready Neighborhood Program Information

The Lakeway Wildfire Ready Neighborhood Program is intended to involve Lakeway neighborhood groups in promoting public safety through Firewise and Ready! Set! Go! Programs and encourage action through Home Ignition Zone Assessments and neighborhood fuel reduction workday programs.

Goals:

- Public safety
- Public awareness
- Homeowner action to harden homes and create defensible spaces
- Neighborhood/HOA workdays to create defensible space on private property and in common areas and greenbelts
- Ongoing maintenance of common areas and greenbelts

Program Outline

- Conduct Neighborhood Wildland Fire Risk Evaluation with Lake Travis Fire Rescue
- Wildfire Ready education presentation at neighborhood group/HOA Meeting
- Consult on-site with individual homeowners identifying wildland fire risk and mitigation
- Assist with workday planning for fuel reduction and maintenance planning on common areas, greenbelts and individual properties
- Provide with no-cost, on-site dumpster(s) if circumstances permit
- Encourage annual Wildfire Readiness education
