How to Dispose of Christmas Trees & Gift Wrap

You can take your real Christmas trees to Public Works at 3303 Serene Hills Dr. weekdays from December 27 through January 7 between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please be sure to take off all lights and decorations before dropping it off. If you drop a tree off on the weekend, please do not block the gate.

If you prefer, we can pick up your real or artificial tree as part of our bulky waste program. Just call us at 512.314.7514 a few days before your service day to schedule. The tree needs to be less than six feet tall for pick up.

Plain wrapping paper can be recycled, but sheets with foil, glitter, wax or plastic cannot.

Plain paper bags can be recycled, but those with other materials cannot. Save your gift bags and use them again next year!

Ribbons and bows are not recyclable and can clog up recycling machinery. Remove them from paper and bags you plan to recycle, and reuse them.

Tissue paper cannot be recycled because it's often made of recycled fibers. You can reuse it, and even use a low heat iron to smooth it out!
